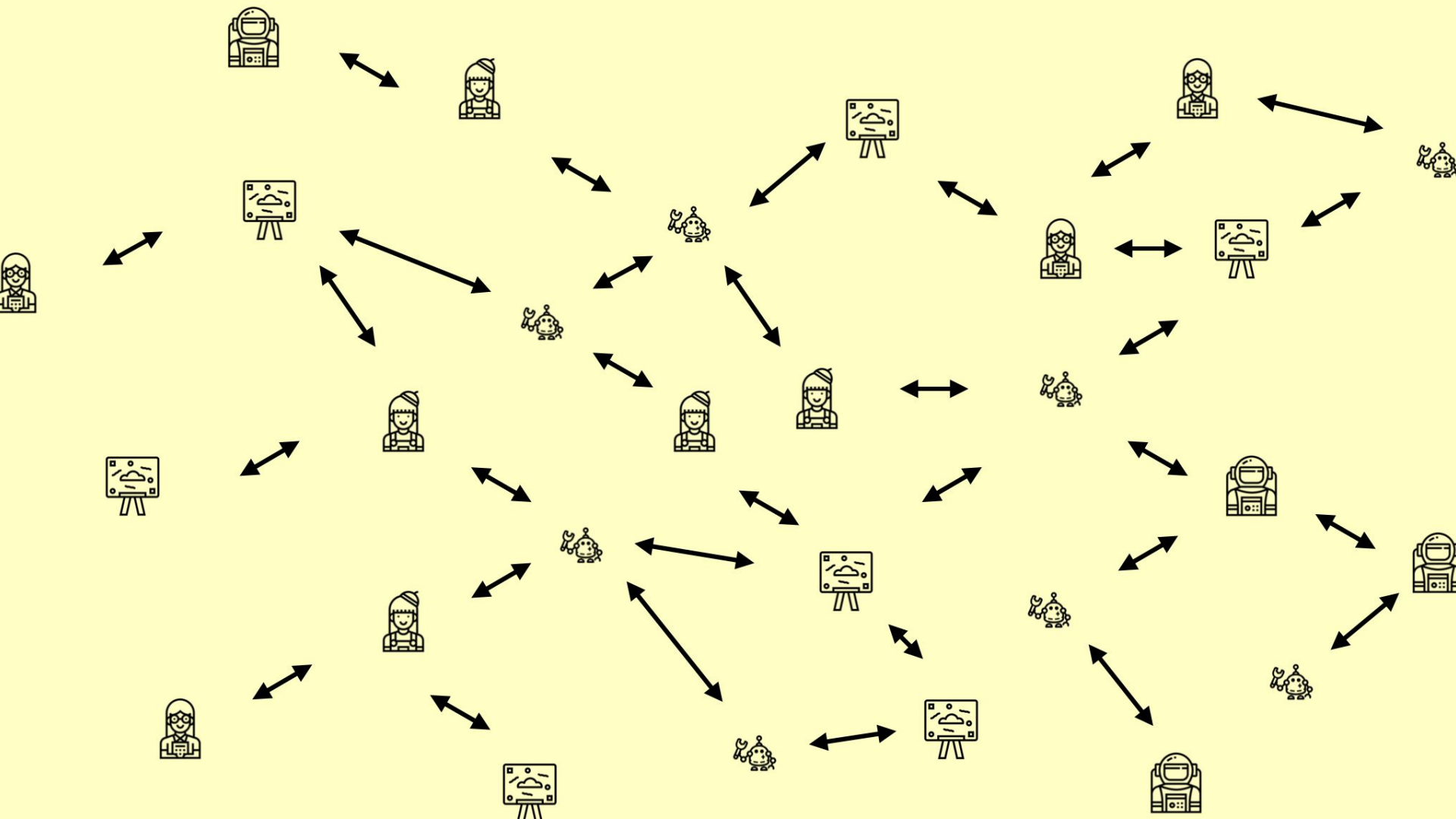

# Strategies for Success

- Pick a specific industry e.g. healthcare, legal documents, etc. and create something that fits the requirements of that field. A great solution for a specific industry beats a generic solution applied to all industries.
- Dive into the nuances of language, such as humor, idiom, sarcasm, alliteration, and more. Language translation is both an art and a science to some people.
- Interview diverse stakeholders. Find bilingual people, ESL students, and Stanford professors of foreign languages.
